

Ian Gordon leads Logarithmic Ltd, supporting organisations to develop their capability in fusion energy. Prior to this, Ian served for ten years at the IAEA (International Atomic Energy Agency). Latterly, he led the IAEA programme on education and training for member states, and previously led the Waste Technology Section, providing support to 178 countries on the safe and effective management of all forms of radioactive waste. Prior to joining the IAEA, Ian worked at the Sellafield nuclear site (UK), where he led several major projects – including the construction of a new store for intermediate level waste, successful negotiations with Japanese utilities on the supply of MOX (Mixed Oxide Fuel), and strengthening emergency arrangements at Sellafield.
