

Simone Arnaldi is Professor of Sociology at the University of Trieste (Italy). His research focuses on science and technology studies, with particular attention to the governance of emerging technologies, responsible research and innovation, public engagement with science, and science diplomacy. Across these areas, he has participated in several national and European research projects and published books, book chapters, and peer-reviewed articles. He has been a visiting scholar at the Institute for Technology Assessment and Systems Analysis at the Karlsruhe Institute of Technology (ITAS/KIT). He was President of the Italian Society for Science and Technology Studies (STS Italia) and currently serves as Co-chair of the EU Science Diplomacy Alliance.
